**STIPULATED ORDER MODIFYING FINAL APPROVAL HEARING
DATE**

Plaintiffs, individually and on behalf of those similarly situated, and Defendant 700Credit, LLC, by and through their respective counsel, have met and conferred as to the date set for the Final Approval Hearing and submit that good cause exists to modify the Final Approval Hearing date set for December 15, 2026 to an earlier date. The Court, having determined that good cause exists to modify the date for the Final Approval Hearing, shall reset the date.

Accordingly, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. On June 3, 2026, Plaintiffs filed their unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement. ECF No. 49.
2. On June 4, 2026, the Court entered an Order granting Plaintiffs'

Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement (the “Preliminary Approval Order”). ECF No. 50.

3. In granting the Preliminary Approval Order, the Court set the date for the Final Approval Hearing as December 15, 2026. ECF No. 50, PageID.697.

4. Following receipt of the Preliminary Approval Order and the date set for the Final Approval Hearing, the Parties met and conferred and discussed the most efficacious date and/or timeframe for the Final Approval Hearing.

5. The Parties agree that an earlier date for the Final Approval Hearing would best serve the Settlement Class and this litigation as a whole, and that a period of approximately 120 days from issuance of the Preliminary Approval Order to the Final Approval Hearing date is optimal—as it would provide sufficient time for Notice to be received and all necessary steps to be complete while avoiding unnecessary delay of the Class benefits.

6. Accordingly, the Parties agree that a hearing date set between October 5, 2026 through October 9, 2026, or as soon thereafter as may be practicable for the Court, would be preferred.

Thus, for good cause shown, the reset date for the Court to hold the Parties Final Approval hearing is **October 7, 2026 at 2:00 pm.**
